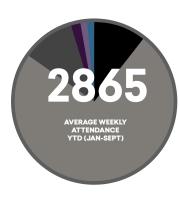

These initiatives are bearing more fruit each year as the nations are being equipped and sent for the glory of God!

Worship Programming \$322,100

The task of the Worship Programming division takes lead on creating great gatherings for our faith family where people can experience the presence of God and respond to His truth for life change. Every week guests, families, seekers and those close to Christ are connected to God through weekend environments LifePoint offers. The Worship Programming division includes the Production and Worship departments.

Next Gen \$529,700

Comprised of birth through college age, the Next Gen division invests in children and families. Partnering with parents, we are passionate about pointing the next generation to Christ. We are blessed to see children, teenagers, and young adults trusting their lives to Jesus and discovering their full potential in Christ.

Adult Ministries \$309.650

This ministry has a multi-faceted approach, helping new and long time believers grow as disciples in Christ and build community through groups, classes, and the institutes. The stories of life change are discovered weekly as we connect and disciple people through biblical counseling, bible study, prayer, Rooted, Life and D-groups. \$1,009,021

Our diverse administration budget represents general operating expenses, utilities, building maintenance.

Personnel

\$4,184,642

We are blessed to have a unified, passionate staff that lead, serve and equip our faith family to BE the church. We are all missionaries and ambassadors for Christ in our world. Our pastors and staff are not hired guns, but servants who "equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ" (Ephesians 4). Our Personnel budget represents salary and benefits for 45 full-time and 19 part-time employees.

\$355,000
