STUDENT RULES

1. RESPECT OTHERS, YOURSELF & CAMP PROPERTY.

- Bad attitudes or actions to harm facilities, adults, yourself or other campers will be dealt with accordingly.
- Practical jokes will not be tolerated.

2. BE WHERE YOU ARE SUPPOSED TO BE WHEN YOU ARE SUPPOSED TO BE THERE.

- This includes always traveling with your group leaders. There are places where once you arrive, your group may split up (such as at the pool or during meals), but you MUST gather back together with your leader before you leave that location. Students should NEVER be walking around camp without a group leader or other adult accompanying them.
- Remain in small group time, quiet time, rec, clean up, & other scheduled activities for the full budgeted time unless told otherwise by camp staff. Groups that wrap up early & head to the next activity or meal can disrupt focused time and/or scheduled activities for others.
- During sessions, please try to conduct bathroom breaks before or after the session. We understand there are urgent situations, but we would like to do what we can to keep distractions during this time minimal.
- No guys in girls' dorms beyond the common room and vice versa.
- Outside of the approval of camp staff, deans, or medics, students should not be on golf carts.

3. EXERCISE MODESTY BOTH OUTSIDE & INSIDE OF CABINS.

- This includes following the dress code guidelines.
- This also applies in bathrooms & showers. Give privacy to yourself & others.

4. ALCOHOL, TOBACCO (INCLUDING: VAPES, JUULS, CIGARETTES), DRUGS, AND WEAPONS ARE ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED.

- Students found with these items will be dealt with appropriately.
- We reserve the right to have luggage checked (at minimum 2 adults will be present for this).

5. ELECTRONICS SHOULD NOT BE BROUGHT TO CAMP.

- Includes cell phones, video games systems, smart watches, etc.
- We will have a place to collect electronics before we leave Smyrna, & these items will be kept in a safe & returned upon our arrival back from camp.
- If a student is found with a cell phone or other electronic device once we leave the church, it will be confiscated and kept in staff possession until we return.
- Non-smart wrist watches & simple alarm clocks (no music + smart features) are options for students who want to keep up with the time.
- Cameras can be brought at your own risk. Images should NOT be captured inside of dorm rooms, bathrooms, or any other areas that risk the privacy of yourself or others.

6. REFRAIN FROM PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION.

At Camp Whatever, we are committed to creating a respectful, Christ-centered environment for all campers. In order to do this, we ask that students refrain from any public displays of affection (PDA) that suggest romantic intentions, such as hand-holding, hugging, kissing, or other physically affectionate behavior. Staff reserves the right to address and investigate interactions that may appear to have a romantic intent to ensure a distraction-free experience for all our students and leaders.
